(PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR CY 2021)

This Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 3 is issued to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bid Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

| ISSUE/S | CLARIFICATION/ADDENDUM/MODIFICATION |
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| As regards the statement of all on-going government and private contracts, are supporting documents required to be submitted, or a statement/matrix will suffice? | A summary statement or matrix stating all on-going government and private contracts will suffice. |
| How about completed government and private contracts, are supporting documents required? | Yes, supporting documents should be submitted with respect to Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the Project being procured. |
| On Section VII (Technical Specifications) of the bidding documents, are the bidders required to submit supporting documents or they are allowed to just answer “compliant or non-compliant”? | The prospective bidders are allowed to indicate “compliant” or “non-compliant” without need to attach supporting documents. The BAC may require the submission of pertinent documents if the BAC finds it necessary. |
| Additional requirement of evacuation and emergency plans | The bidders are required to submit also their emergency and evacuation plans. The bidders may coordinate with the BAC Secretariat through Mr. Emil Purruganan or Mr. Rafael Belisano (both GSD and members of the Secretariat), through the contact details indicated in the invitation to bid, considering that there is need to ask for clearance from the management before inspection may be conducted. |

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| If the bidder is a PhilGEPS Platinum member, is it still required to submit mayor's/business permit, SEC registration? | No more need. |
| Administrative fee | Not less than 20% of the total cost per DOLE Department Order No. 150-16, series of 2016. |
| Amount due the employee and government | Bidders, in fixing their bid proposals, should not sacrifice the amounts mandatory for the employee and the government. |
| Opening of bids | A combination of Virtual via Zoom application and physical attendance for the bid opening shall be conducted on 21 December 2020, 1:15 p.m. at the NCIP Conference Room, 7th Floor, Sunnymede IT Center Building, 1614 Quezon Avenue, Quezon City . Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to participate at the link to be provided upon registration and who choose to attend at the afore-mentioned address. Late bids shall not be accepted. |
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Reminders:

- Submission of bids will be on or before December 21, 2020, Monday, 1:00 PM.
- Bidders shall sign all documents that need the signature of the authorized representative.
- Late bids shall not be accepted.
